Local Open Stock Street Diesel 4WD Truck Friday, July 15, 2011 at 6:30 pm

Limited to Jersey, Greene, Calhoun, Macoupin and Madison County only After ITPA Classes.

The following class rules apply:

1. Axles, drive train, engine block must be OEM.
2. No propane, nitrous or water injection.
3. No riders.
4. Must have explosion proof bell housing/blanket on automatic.
5. DOT tires only (NO cutting)
6. Weights must be securely fastened on front bumper.
7. All safety equipment required...driveshaft loops (front and back) and blocked rear axle.
8. Universal joint protection on rear end.
9. Must be licensed and insured (and matching).
10. Hitch must pull from bumper or Reese hitch at the end of 8' bed or if mounted behind rear axle.
11. 26 inch max hitch height.
12. No fuel cell in cab of truck
13. No drinking and driving.
14. Person in charge of pull has final decision on rules.
15. No complaining.

Absolutely NO Registration After 7:00 p.m.

Must have Large Twisted Clevis.

Two Classes of Local Stock 4WD Trucks

Friday, July 15, 2011 at 6:30 p.m

Limited to Jersey, Greene, Calhoun, Macoupin and Madison County only.

Class I:

Super Stock 4WD Trucks Limited to Trucks with these engines and rules

- A. Diesel Engines
- B. V-10 Engines
- C. 420 Cubic Inch or Larger Engines

Class II:

Stock 4WD Trucks Limited to Trucks Not Equipped for the Super Stock 4WD Truck Class

The following rules apply to both classes:

1. Truck must be 4WD only.
2. Drivers license required. Under 18 must have parent or guardian consent.
3. Limited to one pull per truck
4. Safety chain for bumper style hitch required.
5. 3/8" chain through clevis secured to each frame rail with 1/2" bolts. Not required with Reese style hitch.
6. 1/4" chain temporary drive shaft loops or 1 1/2" nylon straps.
7. Nothing loose in bed, empty toolbox and empty floorboard.
8. No weights, no fuel tanks (auxiliary in bed).
9. No dual wheels.
10. No solid suspension – stock rear suspension only.
11. 26" hitch height **LARGE** twisted clevis (with 3" opening)
12. Truck driven to fairgrounds, licenses, and proof of license.
13. DOT tires uncut.
14. Points of hook-up must be behind rear of frame or bed
15. Headers will be allowed with mufflers – no cut out.
16. Original fuel system, stock fuel tank, stock location.
17. No nitrous – no alternative fuel.
18. No aftermarket traction devices
19. Motor in stock location.
20. Original type engine.
21. No internal or external modification.
22. No high performance CAMS or aftermarket heads.
23. Must run air cleaner.
24. **Will be required to start engine at Tech inspection.**
25. Must be in vehicle to start.
26. Must be in vehicle seat while running.
27. No turbo charged motors, super charged motor on gasoline.
28. Required to attend driver's meeting prior to event.
29. Vehicle must have O.E.M. or flat bed.
30. Must be pickup style chassis.
31. No chassis style trucks with pickup or flat beds. For example: Dodge 4500 Series, International CXT, Chevy C4500, Ford F450, H1 Hummer, etc.

All trucks must be inspected!

Three Classes of Local Farm Stock Pulls

July 16, 2011

Following the NTPA Pull

The Jersey County Fair is having local Farm Stock classes for the Fair. The classes are 12,000; 15,000 and 21,000 lb. To accommodate different horsepower and weight ranges. The classes will be for Jersey, Greene, Macoupin & Calhoun counties only. Classes will pull after NTPA classes.

The following rules are required:

1. Two wheel drive only. NOTE: Front wheel assist accepted using two wheel drive only.
2. **NO** dual wheels in 12,000 and 15,000 lb. Class.
3. Must be out of field tractors with original equipment.
4. **NO** horsepower enhancing liquids or gases.
5. Stock R.P.M. only – engines will be checked.
6. **NO** track type machines.
7. Pull from O.E.M. drawbar only.
8. **NO** sharpened tires allowed.
9. Tractor must have OEM hydraulics installed and in working order.
10. **NO** tractors allowed that compete in pulling organizations.
11. Drawbar clevis with 3 ½ inch opening required.
12. Maximum drawbar height – 21 inches
13. All tractors must weigh at our designated scale **NO** weighing at other scales accepted.
14. Must be 18 years old to drive.
15. Must have original type air cleaner system installed and connected to intake system on engine.
16. Must have stock intake and exhaust manifolds.
17. Must provide current drivers license at registration.
18. Tractors pulling in the farm stock classes cannot pull in the Open Farm Stock Class.
19. Tractors that qualify to pull in Open Farm Stock class or have ever pulled in the open class can not pull in stock class. No exceptions.
